#### LYRiK Awards

Established in 2006, the Leadership, Youth and Respect in Kwinana (LYRiK) Awards recognise and celebrate the achievements of Kwinana young people aged 10 - 24 years.

A young person or group of young people can be nominated for one of six LYRiK Award categories in two age groups, 10 - 17 years and 18 - 24 years. Every Award winner will receive a \$250 cash prize and an invitation to attend a Leadership Day following the awards ceremony.

Each Award category has been linked to several relevant goals from the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals to enable Kwinana young people to see their achievements in the context of a global framework.

To be eligible applicants need to:

- live, work or go to school in the City of Kwinana
  - Be between the ages of 10-24
  - Be 10 by the 1st May 2025

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- Be 24 and not turning 25 for the duration of the program which ends on the 25th June 2025
