LYRiK Awards

Established in 2006, the Leadership, Youth and Respect in Kwinana (LYRiK) Awards recognise and celebrate the achievements of Kwinana young people aged 10 – 24 years.

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A young person or group of young people can be nominated for one of six LYRiK Award categories in two age groups, 10 – 17 years and 18 – 24 years. Every Award winner will receive a \$250 cash prize and an invitation to attend a Leadership Day in July.

Each Award category has been linked to several relevant goals from the United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals to enable Kwinana young people to see their achievements in the context of a global framework.

- Live, work or study in Kwinana
- Must be between 10-24yrs by the 1st May 2024
